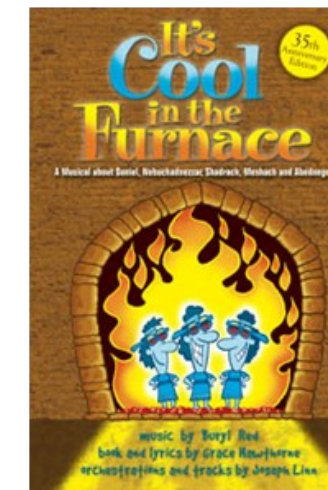
Hawthorne. Children in grades 1-5 will continue to explore the gifts and talents they have to offer to worship God.

We've all used words while being a little uncertain of the actual meaning. But when it comes to words like "belief," "righteousness" and "salvation", our understanding makes a huge difference in how we live our Christian faith and how we view God. So, we're going to take a look at these commonly used words and figure out not only what they mean today, but what they meant to the writers of the Bible thousands of years ago.
