Main Campus Class Schedule

Preschool/Children:

"Mission Friends" (Babies- 4 years)

Mission Friends will provide the building blocks of faith and a basic awareness of God's love for all people. Our goal is to engage preschoolers of all ages in hands-on mission discipleship activities.

Students:

"Project Praxis"

Praxis means "*practice, as distinguished from theory; application or use, as of knowledge or skills.*" Students will be using Wednesday nights to prepare for teaching the lessons for our younger ages. It is an opportunity for them to take what they know and share it with others in a way that helps student leaders learn and use their spiritual gifts. July 9th- Jean Yonce & Jackie Sprague:

"Phoenix Pass/Family Promise: Changing Lives One Family at a Time"

Phoenix Pass serves the needs of women and their children experiencing temporary homelessness by giving them an opportunity to reestablish self-sufficiency in a residential setting. The program at Phoenix Pass provides participants with supportive services and the resources to recover and rebuild a productive, stable lifestyle for themselves and their children. The Phoenix Pass Program implements a program curriculum focusing on financial stability, job skills, family management, education, and spiritual growth.

A mother loses her job, a father is kept from working by an injury, a family is forced from their home by fire or natural disaster. Health care costs soar, public transportation is underfunded, affordable housing is almost impossible to find. These are the reasons why families now make up 40% of the homeless population, and why 1 out of every 4 homeless people is a child. In response to this crisis, Family Promise brings the faith community together to help families regain their housing, their independence, and their dignity. Family Promise is a partnership of congregations within a community helping families who are facing homelessness. It offers an opportunity for volunteers of all faiths to reduce homelessness and transform lives. Come learn how this exciting ministry is impacting both Rockdale and Newton Counties.

"Refuge Pregnancy Center:


The History of Refuge and Evolution of Pregnancy Centers"
